DAY FOUR – Anna Ruby Falls and Historic Boone Tavern

This morning, our first stop will be Anna Ruby Falls, one of the 21 waterfalls in the area. We also visit the Museum of Appalachia, depicting the history of the Appalachian people. Be sure to see the popular Appalachian Hall of Fame Building and the People's Building, with over a quarter million items. End the day in Berea, the folk arts and craft capital of Kentucky. Dinner and overnight is at the historic Boone Tavern Hotel, built in 1909 to accommodate visitors to Berea College. (Breakfast and dinner)
